All treatments have the possibility of some side effects and some of these can last longer than others. Not everyone will experience side effects, and some may have more difficulty with them than others.

Below are some of the more common side effects which you may experience.

- Menopausal related side-effects
- Fatigue
- Lymphoedema (swelling of arm, hand or breast)

You may also have questions about your diet and exercise which we would be happy to address.

If you would like any information about any of these or any other side effects that you are experiencing, please ask us.

The Aintree Breast Unit has a rehabilitation service which gives you access to dieticians, physiotherapists and other therapists who may be able to help. Their contact telephone numbers are at the end of this leaflet. You can also contact a breast care nurse to discuss referral. Some of the specialist services we offer focus on:

- Stress management
- Counselling and support
- Lymphoedema
- Menopausal side effects
- · Fertility issues
- Sexuality issues
- Look good...feel better workshops (available for up to a year after finishing treatment)

- Body image issues
- Acupuncture for hot flushes

We can also put you in touch with our hospital multi-faith chaplains who would be happy to talk to you about any spiritual issues you may have.

If there are any other issues which concern you that are not covered here, please discuss them with your breast care nurse, who will be able to advise you on where to get more information as you need it.
