General Information

A Multi-disciplinary team caters for the needs of people with permanent mobility problems.

The team includes a Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine, Therapists, Rehabilitation Engineers and Administration staff.

The team also has access to other health care professionals as needed e.g. nursing staff, tissue viability nurse etc. and will liaise closely with other hospitals and community/education colleagues when appropriate.

The patient and their family/carers are the most important members of the team and their views are always taken into consideration.

Wheelchair Service

South Sefton Wheelchair service provides and maintains wheelchairs free of charge to people of all ages who are likely to have a mobility problem for more than 3 months.

Manual and powered wheelchair assessments are carried out to determine what type of equipment is most appropriate for your needs.

Complex Mobility Seating Service

This service is consultant led; it provides assessment/prescription and review of patients who require supportive seating, non-standard wheelchairs, active user chairs, pressure relieving cushions and buggies.

Assessments may be carried out at the Centre or in the client's home, hospital, school, workplace or Day Centre.

Referrals can be made by hospital and community colleagues e.g. Consultants, General Practitioners, Therapists and other health care professionals.

Maintenance and Repairs

A private company has the contract for the delivery, collection, modification maintenance and repair of wheelchairs.

They have trained staff, workshops and a mobile team of mechanics who undertake deliveries, collections and minor repairs at the patient's home.

Customer Services

We always aim to deliver a positive experience to all of our patients.

However, if you have any concerns about the service you are receiving, we would suggest that you speak to the clinician providing your care in the first instance.

They may be able to reassure you concerning your progress or may be able to resolve the issue for you.
